## Forced Marriage

When two people love each other, they might choose to get married. In any marriage, *both* partners should *want to* and *agree* to get married.

No one should be forced to marry someone they don't want to. It's wrong and it's against the law.

There are lots of reasons why some families force their children to marry, including: cultural traditions; concerns about reputation and honour in the family; money; disapprove of their child being lesbian, gay, or bisexual; don't want their children to have relationships or sex; and pressure by the community or other family members. They might even believe it's best for you.

None of these reasons are okay.

## **Arranged Marriage**

Sometimes, parents from two families will arrange for their children to get married once they are old enough. This is OK as long as both partners want to marry each other and agree to the marriage.

YES, I DO! (want to get married)

## **Forced Marriage**

This is different. It's where one or both of the partners are forced to marry when they don't want to. An arranged marriage can turn into a forced marriage if your parents don't respect your right to say 'no'.

A marriage is also 'forced' if one of the partners doesn't have the ability to consent.

(e.g. a child under 16 years, or an adult with learning disability)



You might love your parents but might also feel angry, nervous, and distressed about being forced to marry. They might have told you that you're bringing shame on your family if you don't marry. They might even have said that they'll disown you, or threatened you with violence.

This is abuse.

Worried that you're going to be forced to marry someone?

Feeling trapped in a marriage you didn't choose?

In the UK, if you're under 16 and are being pressured to marry, this is child marriage and it's illegal.
